Course Description:

This course covers about 140 commonly-used individual herbs, including their therapeutic functions, clinical indications, commonly-seen combination conditions and precautions.

Textbook and References:

Chinese Herbal Medicine Materia Medica (Third edition), Bensky, D and Gamble A, Seattle, Eastlan Press.

Objectives:

1. The students will be able to know the properties, functions and chief indications of commonly used tonifying herbs, stabilizing and binding herbs, Herbs calming the spirit (Shen), herbs that open orifice, Herbs that extinguish wind and stop tremor, Herbs that expel parasites, emetic herbs, and Herbs for external application.

2. The students will be able to know the similarities and differences among the herbs in the same category, and know how to properly select herbs in treating diseases.

Learning Outcomes/ Competencies:

A student successfully completing Individual Herbs II will acquire basic knowledge of basic theory of TCM, and western pharmacology.

Topics and Content:

Learning Methods:

Lectures will be combined with the audio-visual aids such as movies, slides, video-tapes, as well as the appreciation and evaluation of the genuine scrolls and objects. Discussions, group studies, individual coaching would be greatly encouraged.

Course Requirements:

- A. Classroom attendance: students are required to attend all classes all of the time.
- B. Exams are the middle the final.

Evaluation and Grading:

Grades are determined by taking the average of all exam scores, with instructors reserving the right to adjust the Final Grade based on other academic factors, such as class participation, attendance, overall comprehension, effort, and trimester improvement.
